Responsibilities:

1. Lead a small group of 6-8 students in discussion of designated and provided curriculum.
2. Promote fellowship within the group through group fellowship activities such as game nights, movie nights, putt-putt golf, etc. for your small group.
3. Foster a sense of community and belonging for your group by showing you genuinely care for your members and encourage the members of your group to care for one another as well. This is done by celebrating birthdays within the group, praying for each other on a regular basis, occasionally sharing a meal together, etc.
4. Attend leadership team meetings and contribute as a member of the team to promote growth within The Bridge. Offer your constructive criticism of programs and events to help The Bridge become stronger and more effective.
5. Help to grow the ministry of The Bridge by being an advocate and recruiter for The Bridge on campus.

Responsibilities:

1. Attend any and all organizational meetings concerning the university's intramural leagues
2. Organize, coordinate, and lead a minimum of two (2) intramural teams in different sports throughout the course of an academic year for The Bridge
3. Publicize to the membership of The Bridge all intramural sports where The Bridge will be sponsoring a team.
4. Work in coordination with the staff of The Bridge to obtain funding for equipment needed (i.e. uniforms, sports equipment, etc.)
5. Ensure that all teams sponsored by The Bridge follow the rules and guidelines for intramural sports as set forth by the university.
6. Attend all Leadership team meetings and contribute as a member of the leadership team
7. Organize additional recreation opportunities for The Bridge such as games at the spring cook out, fall kick off event, spring and freshmen retreats, etc.

Requirements:

3. Attend 60% of all regular weekly meetings/activities of The Bridge (i.e. Koinonia, Bible Study, etc.)

3. Attend 60% of all regular weekly meetings/activities of The Bridge (i.e. Koinonia, Bible Study, etc.)
